**ORDER FOR CONTINUING MEDICAL**  
**EDUCATION**

**(NON-DISCIPLINARY)**

7 At its public meeting on April 14, 2010, the Arizona Medical Board ("Board") voted to issue  
8 Marc A. Bauder, M.D. ("Physician") a non-disciplinary Continuing Medical Education (CME) Order  
9 for inappropriate prescribing of narcotics containing acetaminophen in violation of A.R.S. § 32-  
10 1401(27)(q). The Board ordered Physician to obtain 22.5 hours of Board staff pre-approved  
11 Category I non-disciplinary CME by completing the PACE prescribing course within six months  
12 pursuant to A.R.S. §32-1451(E)(2). The CME hours shall be in addition to the hours required for  
13 the biennial renewal of medical licensure. This matter does not rise to the level of discipline.

14 **ORDER**

15 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Physician shall, within six months, obtain 22.5 hours of  
16 Board Staff pre-approved Category I Continuing Medical Education ("CME") by completing the  
17 PACE prescribing course, and provide Board Staff with satisfactory proof of attendance. The CME  
18 hours shall be in addition to the hours required for biennial renewal of his medical license.  
19 Physician's failure to complete the CME will subject him to future disciplinary action by the Board.  
20 A.R.S. § 32-1401(27)(r).

22 **RIGHT TO APPEAL**

23 **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that, pursuant to A.R.S. § 41-1092.03, any person aggrieved by this  
24 decision may apply to the Board, in writing, within thirty (30) days of receipt and request a public  
25 hearing with respect to this order. You may request a hearing by filing a notice of appeal. The

1 notice of appeal must be filed with the Board's Executive Director, and should include your name,  
2 address, the action being appealed, and a concise statement of the reasons for the appeal. If you  
3 request a public hearing, the hearing will be scheduled within sixty (60) days of receipt of your  
4 request. If you request a public hearing, you also have the right to request an informal settlement  
5 conference by filing a written request with the Board, pursuant to A.R.S. § 41-1092.06, no later than  
6 twenty (20) days before the scheduled hearing. The conference will be held within fifteen (15) days  
7 after receipt of your request. Please note that you waive any right to object to the participation of  
8 the Board's representative in the final administrative decision of the matter if it is not settled at the  
9 conference.
