BOMEX Inquiry (11/14/94) -- Robbi Borjeson, M.D.

Dear Dr. Borjeson:

On July 25, 1997, you appeared with your attorney, Kraig Marton, for an informal interview before the Arizona Board of Medical Examiners ("Board"). Based on the information presented, the Board voted to resolve the complaint listed above by issuing a Letter of Reprimand to you.

A Letter of Reprimand is defined in A.R.S. § 32-1401(15) as "a disciplinary letter issued by the Board that informs the physician that the physician's conduct violates state or federal law but does not require the Board to restrict the license or monitor the physician because the physician's conduct did not harm a patient or the public."

In voting to issue the Letter of Reprimand, the Board adopted the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order:

Findings of Fact

1. The Board of Medical Examiners of the State of Arizona is the duly constituted authority for the regulation and control of the practice of medicine in the State of Arizona.
2. Robbi Borjeson, M.D. is the holder of License No. 24093 for the practice of medicine in the State of Arizona.
3. On 4/20/96 Dr. Borjeson appeared before the Board for a licensing interview and agreed to enter into a Stipulation and Order with the Board, that included a requirement that she would continue psychological treatment with a Board approved psychologist with quarterly reports to the Board.

4. Dr. Borjeson appeared before the Board of Medical Examiners on 7/25/97 and admitted that she was not and had not been in compliance with the Stipulation. On 7/25/97 Dr. Borjeson stated her willingness to immediately comply with the Stipulation, and submitted the name of a psychologist for approval.

Conclusions of Law

1. The Board of Medical Examiners possesses jurisdiction over the subject matter hereof and over Robbi Borjeson, M.D.

2. The conduct and circumstances described above constitute unprofessional conduct pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-1401(25)(r) (Violating a formal order, probation, consent agreement or stipulation issued or entered into by the board or its executive director under the provisions of this chapter).

Order

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, it is hereby ordered that Robbi Borjeson, M.D. be issued a Letter of Reprimand.
