

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The Board is the duly constituted authority for the regulation and control of the practice of medicine in the State of Arizona.
2. Dr. Casebeer is the holder of License No. 6024 for the practice of medicine in the State of Arizona.
3. On or around December 3, 1998, Dr. Casebeer self-reported to the Board that he had been diagnosed with a medical condition, systemic myasthenia gravis, which impairs his ability to safely practice medicine. Upon receiving this letter the Board initiated investigation No. 12575.
4. Dr. Casebeer has three other open investigations against him, Investigation Nos. 12486, 12624, 12623. The Board makes no findings of fact regarding those investigations.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Board possesses jurisdiction over the subject matter hereof and over Dr. Casebeer as a licensee of the Board; and,
2. The Board is the duly constituted authority for the regulation and control of the practice of medicine in the State of Arizona, pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-1401, et. seq.
3. The Board has specific statutory authority at A.R.S. § 32-1451(A) and (L) to take action against a doctor with a medical disability that impairs his ability to safely

1 engage in the practice of medicine.

2 4. The Board makes no conclusions of law regarding Investigation Nos.
3 12486, 12624, 12623.

4 **CONSENT ORDER**


5 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

6 1. Dr. Casebeer is permanently restricted from the clinical practice of
7 medicine, i.e., medical diagnosis and treatment of patients, including ophthalmology and
8 ophthalmic surgery. Dr. Casebeer shall limit his practice of medicine in the State of
9 Arizona to lecturing, teaching, statistical analysis and medical research. Said restriction
10 on Dr. Casebeer's Board license to practice medicine is due to a diagnosed medical
11 condition, systemic myasthenia gravis. On December 3, 1998, Dr. Casebeer reported to
12 the Board that he is suffering from this condition and that it impairs his ability to safely
13 practice medicine.

14 2. In regard to the above investigation cases (Nos. 12575, 12486, 12624, and
15 12623), they are disposed of and resolved by the entry of this Order.
